ORDINANCE No. 1 of 1873. (DANGEROUS GOODS).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Dangerous Goods Ordinance, 1873, the Governor in Council makes the following addition to the regulations under the heading "Exemptions of certain substances from the provisions of the Ordinance" published on pages 19 to 21 of the Regulations of Hong Kong 1844 to 1925:—

Addition.

Alcoholic liquids.

3. Alcoholic liquids of a less strength than 70 parts per cent. by weight of alcohol shall not be deemed to be dangerous goods.
