ORDINANCE No. 9 of 1897. (VAGRANCY).

I, WILFRID THOMAS SOUTHORN, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer Administering the Government of the Colony of Hong Kong and its Dependencies and Vice Admiral of the same, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 3 of the Vagrancy Ordinance, 1897, DO HEREBY CERTIFY Victoria Gaol, the Prison for Males at Lai Chi Kok and the Prison for Females at Lai Chi Kok to be houses of detention AND I APPOINT the Superintendent of Prisons to be Superintendent of the said houses of detention.
