AT THE COURT AT BUCKINGHAM PALACE,
THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1933.

PRESENT,

THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Section 37 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act, 1932, it is enacted that His Majesty, if satisfied that the Government of any country has acceded to the Safety Convention, may, by Order in Council, make a declaration to that effect :

And whereas His Majesty is satisfied that the Governments of the countries hereinafter mentioned have acceded to the Safety Convention :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers vested in Him by the aforesaid Section and of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to declare and doth hereby declare that the **Governments of the following countries** have acceded to the Safety Convention :—

Brazil, China, the Free City of Danzig, Hungary, Iceland, and Portugal.

WHEREAS by Section 65 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act, 1932 (22-23 G. 5, c. 9), it is enacted that His Majesty, if satisfied that the **Government of any country** has ratified or acceded to the Load Line Convention, or that such Convention has been applied to any country in pursuance of the provisions of Article 21 thereof, may by Order in Council make a declaration to that effect :

And whereas His Majesty is satisfied that the Government of Peru has ratified the Loan Line Convention, that the Governments of Hungary and Roumania have acceded to the said Convention, and that the said Convention has been applied to Netherlands East Indies, Curaçao and Western Samoa :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers vested in Him by the aforesaid Section, and of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to declare and doth hereby declare that

(a) The Government of Peru has ratified the Load Line Convention,

(b) The Governments of Hungary and Roumania have acceded to the Load Line Convention,

(c) The Load Line Convention has been applied to Netherlands East Indies, Curaçao, and Western Samoa, in pursuance of the provisions of Article 21 thereof.
