No. 510.—Government Notification No. 487 of 31st July, 1931, is cancelled and the following substituted therefor:—

It is hereby notified that on and after 28th July, 1933, charges will be made for official examinations by the Colonial Veterinary Surgeon, as follows:—

1. For examination of cattle, sheep, goats and swine for export (including certificate of result):—

for the first 100	50 cents a head.
for any number in the same consignment	}	25 cents a head.
beyond the first 100						
with a minimum fee of \$5.00.						

2. For examination of animals other than cattle, sheep, goats and swine for export (including certificate of result) \$5.00 a head.

3. For examination of food products for export (including certificate of result):—

if covering consignments of not exceeding 500 lbs.	\$ 2.00
“ “ exceeding 500 lbs. and not exceeding 1,000 lbs.	\$ 2.50
