ORDINANCE No. 39 of 1931. (TOBACCO).

In exercise of the power conferred by the third subsection of section 30 of the Tobacco Ordinance, 1931, the Governor in Council hereby appoints, as the period of each licence issued under the said section, twelve months commencing on the date of its being issued: Provided that where, in any particular case, good cause is shown to the Superintendent for the period of a licence to be less than twelve months, the period of such licence shall be such lesser period deemed by him to be appropriate.
