ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1899. (MERCHANT SHIPPING).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 (2) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1899, the Governor in Council rescinds regulation 23 in Table E (published by Notification No. 81 in the Gazette of the 9th February, 1934) and substitutes the following regulation:—

Night clearance.

23. Subject to the provisions of regulations 24 and 25 of these regulations no launch, ferry vessel or motor boat shall leave any port between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. from October to March inclusive, or between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. from April to September inclusive, without a night clearance for which a fee of one dollar shall be paid.
