ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1899. (MERCHANT SHIPPING).

---

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 (4) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1899, the Governor in Council hereby rescinds regulation 7B in Table M, and substitutes the following regulation:—

7B. Not more than five vessels shall be moored abreast on either side of a ship at a buoy in the Harbour; and not more than three vessels shall be abreast alongside any ship's gangway in the Harbour.
