

HARBOUR DEPARTMENT.

No. 872.—Under powers conferred on the Harbour Master by Ordinance 10 of 1899 it is hereby ordered that:—

Launches, motor boats, junks and sampans entering or leaving the Royal Naval Dockyard basin, shall

- (a) Approach at moderate speed and not exceed slow speed when inside the basin.
- (b) Keep to their starboard side of the entrance.
- (c) When leaving, clear the entrance by 100 yards before turning east or west.
- (d) When entering and coming from east or west, keep 100 yards from the wall before turning in.
- (e) Not enter or leave the basin while a red flag, or a red flag under a black ball, is flying at the Dockyard Signal Station or at a pole at the western end of the north wall of the basin.
- (f) Keep well clear of the dock entrance when a square blue flag is flying at the Dockyard Signal Station.
