**ORDINANCE No. 8 of 1935. (ADULTERATED FOOD  
AND DRUGS).**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Adulterated Food and Drugs Ordinance, 1935, and by section 9 of the Interpretation Ordinance, 1911, the Governor in Council amends the regulations published by Government Notification No. 940 in the Gazette of the 6th December, 1935, as follows:—

**Amendments.**

1. In the heading substitute "the first day of July 1936" for "the first day of January, 1936".

2. In paragraph (xix) of regulation 1 substitute "25.5%" for "27.5%" at the end of the fourth line.
