

so elected shall hold office for twelve months from the first day of the second month of each academic year and shall be eligible for re-election. If any Dean shall vacate office, the Board of that Faculty shall forthwith elect another Dean who shall hold office until the last day of the first month of the next ensuing academic year.

The said amendment having been allowed by the Governor in Council on the 14th day of January, 1936, becomes valid and operative on the publication of this notification.

ORDINANCE No. 6 of the 1901. (RATING).
