It is hereby notified for general information that as from the 1st March, 1936, the scale of charges for certificates issued by the Superintendent of Imports and Exports in the under mentioned matters and for owner's declarations of effects will be as follows:—

Scale of Charges.

1. Certificate of origin of goods when application made before shipment \$1.00
2. Certificate as to origin of goods when application made after shipment \$2.00
3. Certificate of the landing of goods \$5.00
4. Certificate of breakages and/or shortage of cargo damaged or short in bond \$5.00
5. Certificate of accuracy of copy of or extract from office records \$5.00
6. Other Certificates to which signature of the Superintendent is not required by any enactment \$5.00
7. Owner's declaration in respect of personal or household effects liable to any *ad valorem* duty and imported as baggage into Great Britain or Northern Ireland \$5.00
