**Hong Kong.**ORDINANCE No. 16 of 1935. (PUBLIC HEALTH  
[ANIMALS AND BIRDS]).

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (7) of section 7 of the Public Health (Animals and Birds) Ordinance, 1935, the Governor in Council by this order defines, for the purposes of subsection (6) of the said section, the periods of incubation of the undermentioned diseases as hereunder set forth:—

<i>Disease.</i>	<i>Period of Incubation.</i>
Anthrax ... ..	...Fourteen days.
Foot and mouth disease ... ..	...Twenty-one days.
Cattle plague or rinderpest... ..	...Fourteen days.
Septicaemia haemorrhagica... ..	...Fourteen days.
Surra ... ..	...Twenty-one days.
Red Water (Texas fever) ... ..	...Twenty-one days.
Pleuro-pneumonia contagiosa of cattle ...	...Six months.
Buffalo disease ... ..	...Fourteen days.

**LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.**

- Ordinance No. 48 of 1935.—An Ordinance to amend the law relating to the custody of infants.
- Ordinance No. 49 of 1935.—An Ordinance to make better provision in this Colony for the granting by magistrates of separation and maintenance orders.
- Ordinance No. 51 of 1935.—An Ordinance to further and protect the activities of The Girl Guides Association, and to incorporate the Hong Kong Branch thereof.
- Ordinance No. 54 of 1935.—An Ordinance to make provision for the establishment and management of an Exchange Fund and to amend the law relating to Legal Tender in the Colony and to the Notes issued by certain banks.
