ORDINANCE No. 15 of 1922. (WILD BIRDS).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Wild Birds Ordinance, 1922, the Governor in Council further amends the regulations in the Schedule to the said Ordinance by adding the following paragraph to regulation 4:—

(c) The whole of the Island of Hong Kong.
