The lowest reading of the barometer (M.S.L.) was 29ins. 763 at 17h. 00m on the 24th.

The maximum gust velocity of the wind, as recorded by the Dines-Baxendell anemograph, was at the rate of 42 miles per hour at 00^h. 40^m. on the 26th.
