ORDINANCE No. 13 of 1935. [PUBLIC HEALTH (FOOD)].

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Public Health (Food) Ordinance, 1935, the Urban Council makes the following amendment to the by-laws under the heading "Slaughter-houses" and sub-heading "Slaughter of animals" set forth in Schedule to the above-mentioned Ordinance:—

Amendment.

By-law 42 is rescinded and the following by-law is substituted therefor:—

42. Fees in accordance with the following scale shall be paid by the owner of any animal to be slaughtered:—

Cattle (including calves)	55	cents	per	head.
Sheep and goats	30	,,	,,	,,
Swine	40	,,	,,	,,

The fee shall in all cases be payable on admission to the slaughter-house.
