An Ordinance to amend the Female Domestic Service Ordinance, 1923.

[29th May, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Hong Kong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Female Domestic Service Amendment Ordinance, 1936. Short title.

2. Sub-section (3) of section 18 of the Female Domestic Service Ordinance, 1923, as enacted by section 7 of the Female Domestic Service Amendment Ordinance, 1929, is amended by the insertion of the words “and to imprisonment for any term not exceeding six months” after the words “two hundred and fifty dollars” at the end thereof. Amendment of Ordinance No. 1 of 1923, s. 18 (3) as enacted by Ordinance No. 22 of 1929, s. 7.
