COLONIAL SECRETARY'S DEPARTMENT.

It is hereby notified that, in view of the proposals adopted by the Coordinating Committee of the League of Nations that the Governments of Members of the League should abrogate on the 15th July the restrictive measures taken by them in connection with the dispute between Ethiopia and Italy, His Majesty has made on the 10th day of July, 1936, an Order in Council, intituled "The Treaty of Peace (Covenant of the League of Nations) Order, 1936," revoking the Treaty of Peace (Covenant of the League of Nations) Order of the 25th October, 1935 (published by Notification No. 887 in the Hong Kong Government Gazette of the 15th November, 1935.) and Orders of the 9th and 19th November, 1935 (published by Notification No. 16 in the Gazette of the 3rd January, 1936) as from the 15th July, 1936. The application of the Order in Council of the 10th July, 1936,

is similar to that of the Order of the 25th October, 1935, and it is provided that the revocation of the former Orders shall not affect:

- (a) their previous operations or anything duly done or suffered under any of them;
- (b) any rights, privileges, obligations or liabilities acquired, accruing or incurred under any of them;
- (c) any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against them;
- (d) any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid;

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be continued or enforced, and any such penalty, liability, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if the said Orders had not been revoked.

A copy of the Order in Council will be published in the Hong Kong Government Gazette when it is received in the Colony.
