ORDINANCE No. 22 of 1910. (MIDWIVES).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Midwives Ordinance, 1910, the Governor in Council amends the regulations published by Government Notification No. 653 in the Gazette of the 24th October, 1930, as follows:—

Amendment.

Regulation 2 is amended by the insertion of the following paragraph immediately before the proviso at the end thereof.

F. that she possess a certificate of competency satisfactory to the Board, and has practised as a wan p'o in the Colony for at least two years immediately preceding the date of her application to be certified, and that such application is made before the first day of January, 1937.
