ORDINANCE No. 22 of 1910. (MIDWIVES).

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Midwives Ordinance 1910, the Midwives Board further amends the Regulations published as Government Notification No. 653 in the Gazette of the 24th October 1930 as follows:—

Amendments.

Regulation 5 (as amended by Government Notification No. 911 published in the Gazette of the 17th December 1937) is further amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraphs:—

The fee payable to each member of the Board who conducts an examination shall be \$25.00 in respect of each examination.
