ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1933. (VOLUNTEER).

By virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Volunteer Ordinance, 1933, the General Officer Commanding the Troops, with the approval of the Governor after consultation with the Commandant of the Hong Kong Volunteer Defence Corps, amends the First Schedule to the Ordinance as amended by Government Notification No. 903 in the Gazette of the 13th November, 1936, as follows:—
