AND BATHING PLACES REGULATION).

By virtue and in exercise of the powers contained in sections 3 and 4 of the Pleasure Grounds and Bathing Places Regulation Ordinance, 1936, the Governor in Council amends the First Schedule to the said Ordinance, as follows:—
