## Hong Kong.

ORDINANCE No. 37 of 1932. (POLICE FORCE).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 (1) of the Police Force Ordinance, 1932, the Governor in Council further amends the Police Pensions Regulations set forth in Government Notification No. 688 published in the Gazette of the 20th October, 1933, as follows:—

## Amendments.

- (a) Paragraph (1) of regulation 10 is deleted and the following paragraph is substituted therefor:—
- (1) Where it is established to the satisfaction of the Governor in Council that an officer has been guilty of negligence, irregularity or misconduct or that, as in this regulation provided, his conduct has not otherwise been good, a pension, gratuity or other allowance to him may be reduced or altogether withheld.
- (b) Paragraph (4) of regulation 10 is amended by the addition of the words "to him" after the word "granted" at the end thereof.
- (c) The following paragraph is added at the end of regulation 10:—
- (5) Nothing in this regulation shall be deemed to affect the pensions and gratuities provided for in regulations 14 and 15.
